2nd Trimester ends on February 23rd

The second trimester will be winding up soon, the last day coming up on Friday, February 23. Please take a moment to log in to the

Campus Portal – or have your student do it themselves and show you – to review current grades and any missing assignments. Students sometimes find that missing work has piled up over the trimester and try frantically to hand in assignments at the last minute in an effort to recover some grades before the term ends.

Please keep the following school grading policies in mind:

- Because trimester grades are final, work turned in after the end of the term will not impact a previous grade.
- All work is accepted for full Content Knowledge credit prior to the final assessment of each unit, but not to extend beyond the end of the term.

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A Word From the Principal, continued...

The Work Habits grade will be impacted by work that is turned in after the due date.

Because of due dates for posting grades, teachers cannot accept late/missing work after the end of the term. Missing work that is still within the current unit should be turned in as soon as possible to receive content knowledge credit. As throughout the school year, students wishing to improve a grade should talk to their teacher about second chance opportunities that might be available.

CMAS Testing

This spring, students will be taking the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS), a state mandated assessment that determines a student's achievement and academic growth in relation to the Colorado Academic Standards, which are aimed at preparing students for college and career success.

Students will take the assessments on the following dates:

- All grades will take the Math and ELA sessions throughout the day on April 2nd, 3rd and 4th
 - ⇒ Stay tuned for the daily testing schedule, which will be published in March
 - ⇒ Families will be receiving communication if your student is receiving extended time.
- 8th graders will take the science sessions on April 10th (regular scheduled day).

Deer Creek is committed to using a body of evidence to inform us about instruction and students' learning and progress. The data generated from a variety of measures, including CMAS, helps us meet the needs of all of our students and allows us to make decisions to improve student learning and growth.


Here are some additional important facts about the CMAS assessments:

- Students who miss a testing session will make up that session as soon as possible within the state testing window.
- Please ensure that your student is attending school on testing dates. Please avoid late arrivals and early dismissals, as they might interrupt your child's testing session.
- During the testing window, regularly scheduled school learning opportunities will continue.

At Deer Creek, we are committed to preparing students for a promising future full of choices. We value utilizing data to make instructional decisions, while at the same time preserving instructional time in the classroom. We hope that this information is helpful to you and answers questions that you may have about the CMAS assessments. 8th Grade Parents

As we prepare our 8th graders for high school, part of this process is registering for 9th grade classes. Mrs. Jonas and Mrs. Vargo have already met with 8th graders to set them up for success at whichever high school they will attend. Our students learned about registration information, credits and graduation requirements for all Jeffco high schools, options for core classes and electives, and the approaching timeline for our future Chargers. Students and parents can access the slides, links and information on the 8th Grade Counseling Google Classroom.

On February 7th, Chatfield Senior High Counseling Team will be here at Deer Creek to meet with students to begin the registration process. Students will receive paperwork to bring home. Please look over this with your students and complete the course selection together. Chatfield Counselors will return on February 14th to collect the signed forms.

will be assigned English/Language Arts, Math, Social Studies and Science classes, and they will get to request their electives. Information about classes can be found on our website, here.

Your students will be bringing home a registration form for your signature of approval. Forms are due on Monday, February 5 and should be turned into base camp teachers. Students will be entering their elective requests in Campus the week forms are due. Please reach out if you have any questions.

7th Grade Science

The Healthy Decision Making unit will be taught this spring in 7th grade science classes. The focus of this unit is making well-informed decisions about individual health and well-being regarding tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and sexually transmitted diseases. Students will learn the effects of tobacco, alcohol, and other drugs on the brain and body and how these substances influence decision making. Students will learn what sexually transmitted diseases are, how to prevent them, and the difference between HIV and AIDS. Students will learn the effectiveness of different birth control methods with a focus on abstinence. Students will be introduced to a decision making process to help them learn to evaluate risk factors and make healthy decisions for themselves, now and in the future. A parent letter will be sent home with students and posted on Mrs. Saueracker's and Mrs. Dehne's Google Classroom as the start of the unit approaches.



CHOICE REGISTRATION


